An interesting event has happened to us and we'd like to see if we could get an answer to the following*

question: Who was Joseph E. Hoopes, Second Lieutenant; from Pennsylvania; he was assigned to the 12th Field Artillery, 2nd Division; died 28 July 1918; and was buried at the American National Memorial Cemetery at Chateau Thierry, France. We've tried to look him up in the references available to us, with no success.

My wife had the opportunity to travel through France and just decided to stop there and look at the nice chapel there. She started wandering around after leaving the chapel and walked right up to Lieutenant Hoopes' headstone. I chalk it up to inspiration that she found his name out of the thousands buried there. She could have walked in any direction, but walked straight to his location. I'm sure there is an important story behind his life and would like to see him remembered in an article in one of our future newsletters. The battle he fought and died in was very important in World War I history, but just as important, we need a family history record of Lieutenant Hoopes. Who was he and how did he wind up there?

Can anyone help? I researched for what might be likely candidates in the books and eliminated the following: Joseph E. Hoopes Nos. 1894, 2407, 2446, 2991, 3836, 5102, and 5153. The only possibility that's in the books seems to be in Vol I, p 624: #5982 Joseph Edward Hoopes born 1894 - NFI. Son of #3483 Joseph Burk Hoopes, whose parents were Hadley and Mary Jane (Ochiltree) Hoopes. His father Joseph Burk Hoopes was, born 20 Jul 1863 in New Garden, Chester Co., PA; he was a grocer, and he died 13 Nov 1948 in Haddonfield, Camden Co., NJ.

and is buried in Chelton Hills Cemetery in Philadelphia along with his wife, Katherine E. (Talmage) Hoopes, daughter of Edward E. and Margaret (Connelly) Talmage, who was born 29 Nov 1861 in Philadelphia and died 2 Jan 1938 in Haddonfield. Joseph Edward Hoopes had an older brother, Harvey Talmage Hoopes who was born 19 Apr 1890 in Philadelphia. Harvey married 1) on 6 Nov 1912, Nellie G. Hoskins, parents unknown, born 1 Jul 1890 in Philadelphia. Harvey married 2) Ella R. Reynolds. No children known to have been born to either union. If this Joseph Edward Hoopes is the right person, he would have been 24 at the age of his death, a plausible age for an infantry lieutenant. It might also account for the fact that no further information was given about him. But since it's highly unlikely that his brother is still living - he'd be 104 - and there are no known members of a next generation from this line, it may be difficult to determine whether this is the correct Joseph E. Hoopes. The Chester County Historical Society might be a place to research further if someone in that area is willing to take this further.

[excerpts from an email sent by Ron Hoopes, Acton MA, in response to questions about what more information he might have regarding his great grandfather Isaacher Hoopes, author of the diary from which we printed pages containing brief notes of Abraham Lincoln's assassination]

--I believe that you are right about Issacher's occupation, a bookkeeper. But that is not certain at this time. My father (who is 88) believes he was in stocks and bonds. Also, I always thought Issacher lived and worked in Wilmington, Delaware. But, my father believes he lived in northeastern Maryland. I am going to do more research and will keep you posted. Further, I plan to send you a full copy of the diary for your archives and attempt to decipher some of the handwriting.

I am also planning to do some research on the Joshua Hoopes home in England. We visited Tidkinhow farm some years ago. It is reputed to be Joshua's mother's home. She was Isabel Calvert. It looks as if our cousins Reitz and Gamble were looking for or visited the same location???? I plan to call Ms. Reitz and compare notes. I have had for some time an English Ordinance Survey map which shows Tidkinhow farm but the location does not jibe with the footnote (number 16) on page 12, volume 1 of the Hoopes Family History. So, you can see that I have some work to do in that area.

We look forward to receiving the full copy of the diary and any further family information Ron obtains. A number of our family members have visited the Joshua Hoopes home in England. Following are the directions we've been sending; if anyone has corrections or clearer instructions, please let us know.

Directions to The Joshua Hoopes Ancestral Home in Skelton, Yorkshire, England

This is a condensation of the instructions given by Elsie Hoopes Gamble and Helen Hoopes Polk Reitz. It seems that help from people living nearby may be needed to complete the last leg of the journey, though Rosemary Shields went before getting the newsletter offering directions and had no luck. She showed pictures of the house to 5 different locals who said there was no house that old in the area - and 2 of the people had lived there 50+ years.

The house was built in 1160 and is now lived in by a young couple, John and Stephanie Powers, who say that on a clear day you can see the North Sea. Pictures of the house with Stephanie and visitors Elsie Hoopes Gamble; Elsie's niece, Mrs. Don (Cressie) Hoopes; and Elsie's daughter, Joyce Wharton, appear at the back of the "Hoopes Commemerative Booklet, 305th Family Reunion, August 27, 1988."

Elsie says that the people at the library were most helpful, telling them that the Joshua Hoopes farm was 2-1/2 miles north of Moorsholm and 5 miles from Skelton sitting back from the road on a hill.

After having consulted a map, Helen Hoopes Polk Reitz tells that just before leaving for home she looked up Skelton on a map thinking that Moorsholm was too small to be seen on the map. However, 10 minutes before leaving for the airport she suddenly espied *another* Skelton and there was Moorsholm right after it. She got off the train at Middlesborough and saw the house. (Unfortunately, before this, she got off the train from Edinburgh at Middlesborough and took a taxi. More than 60 pounds later, they stopped at still another farm house where she mentioned the name Powers and voila! the people knew what she was talking about.) Joshua Hoopes' farm is off Guisborough Rd. Ask directions because one turns into a farm yard, passes the barn up and left and past a new house and on up to the right, and you have arrived. Helen says if you need further or better directions you can call her in Haddonfield, NJ at 609-429-6210.
